5. **Purpose of hearing:**

A. Suspension or revocation of permit under Health and Safety Code, Section 42307.

<u>Section 42307</u>: An air pollution control officer may request the hearing board to hold a hearing to determine whether a permit should be revoked, if he finds the holder of the permit is violating any applicable order, rule or regulations of the district, or any applicable provision of this division.

B. Variance under Health and Safety Code, Section 42350.

<u>Section 42350</u>: Any person may apply to the hearing board for a variance from <u>Section 41701</u> or from the rules and regulations of the district.

Types of variances:

An Emergency Variance is used when you know the problem can be resolved within 30 days. No public notice is required and the hearing will be before one Board Member. If it will take longer than 30 days to resolve the problem, you will need either a Short Term or Interim variance.

For a Short Term variance, a minimum of 10 day notification, prior to the hearing, is given to the APCO, other Air Basin Districts, ARB, EPA, and yourself. The hearing is before one Board Member and the six findings are required.

For an interim variance, the hearing notification is only given to the APCO and the Source. The hearing is before one Board Member and the six findings are not required at this time, but must be given to receive the regular variance. It is possible to get this variance issued within 24 hours, if needed.

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With both the Short-term and Regular Variances you must also apply for an Interim Variance. At the Short-term Variance stage, notice must be given <u>at least 10 days prior</u> to the hearing. The six findings are required at this stage.

C. Revoking or modifying variance under Health and Safety Code, Section 42356.

Section 42356: The hearing board may modify or revoke, by written order, any order permitting a variance.

D. Review the denial or conditional granting of authorization for Authority to Construct or Permit to Operate Rule 519 of the AQMD Rules and Regulations.

E. Review the denial of certification or withdrawal of certified emission reductions under <u>Rule 412</u> or to review the withdrawal of approval of innovative technology under <u>Rule 418</u>.
